

STEPS FOR MAKING DR. GHOUL YOUR VOICEMAIL MESSAGE

1. Once you have purchased the voicemail message(s) from Dr. Ghoul's website/Bandcamp website, you will want to make sure you downloaded the message as a MP3 file to your computer or smartphone.
2. If you want to add the Dr. Ghoul voicemail message as your VoIP telephone system's voicemail greeting, please follow your particular system's instructions on uploading the MP3 via their website-based telephone system.
3. If you want to add the Dr. Ghoul voicemail message to your cell phone's voicemail greeting, for most modern smartphones, there is not a direct way to upload the MP3 to your phone's voicemail system.
4. Instead, you will need to open the Dr. Ghoul voicemail message on your computer or smartphone and have it ready to play over your computer's speakers or on your smartphone. We suggest turning your computer speakers to a higher volume in order for the message to be picked up by your cell phone's microphone. If playing the message on your cell phone, keep the volume at about 2/3's its max, as too high of volume on your cell phone will cause the message to "scratch" while being recorded by the cell phone's microphone.
5. Next, open your cell phone's voicemail system by calling the voicemail number. Follow your particular cell phone's instructions on getting to your voicemail greeting and how to record a new one.
6. If using a computer to play the Dr. Ghoul voicemail message, when you click "record a new voicemail greeting" on your cell phone's system, you will hold the cell phone close to your computer's speakers and push play on your computer to play the Dr. Ghoul message. Once the message is complete, push the required button on your cell phone to end the recording session, and review to make sure the greeting recorded correctly. It may take a few attempts to get the message correctly recorded on your cell phone's voicemail greeting system.
7. If using your cell phone to play the Dr. Ghoul voicemail message, when you click "record a new voicemail greeting" on your cell phone's system, you will then go to the opened Dr. Ghoul voicemail message file on your cell phone and push play on the message. You should hear the Dr. Ghoul voicemail message being played on your cell phone. Once the Dr. Ghoul message is complete, return back to your voicemail call and push the required button to end recording the greeting. Review to make sure the greeting recorded correctly. It may take a few attempts to get the message correctly recorded on your cell phone's voicemail greeting system.
8. Phone manufacturers and companies are always changing phone capabilities, so check your particular phone's manufacturer and manual to ensure that there is not a direct way to upload a MP3 to your voicemail system. This is one option that many consumers are wanting, so phone companies may start adding this feature in the near future.
